Re: Suspension from Office, Per Article X, Section 5(i), NAACP Constitution

Dear Mr. Wei:

In accordance with Article X, Section 5(i), of the Constitution of the National Association for the Advancement of Colored People (NAACP), please be advised that your position as President of the New Jersey State Conference Youth & College Division has been suspended effective as of the date of this letter.

"When an individual becomes a member of the NAACP, that individual pledges to abide by the rules and policies of the Association and the decisions of the Board of Directors." (Article 10, Section 2). This action is taken to protect the NAACP from the danger of irreparable harm because of the following:

1. Inimical behavior and conduct resulting in your dismissal from the East Sprog Summer Program for which you had received an NAACP scholarship.
2. Failure to provide written reports of all Youth & College activities, including this incident, to the New Jersey State Conference Executive Committee, and failure to attend meetings of the New Jersey State Conference, pursuant to Article VIII, Section 10(c), of the Bylaws for Units.
3. Upon reaching your 25th birthday, you were no longer eligible to serve as an officer in the Youth & College Division of the NAACP (Article IV, Section 6((a)), of the Bylaws for Units).

You have fifteen (15) days from the date of this letter to request a hearing before a Hearing Panel of the National Board of Directors. The request must be in writing and sent to:

You are directed to cease and desist from acting or holding yourself out as the President of the New Jersey State Conference Youth & College Division of the NAACP.
